LOCATION OF THE COURSE

The course lies 3 miles north-east of Lichfield, Staffs., on the west side of the A38. (A directional map is printed on the following page).

CIRCUIT

The length of the figure of eight course is 1467.4 metres, the surface is sealed tarmacadam, not less than 4.3 metres wide.

Any competitor not arrived by 11.30 may be excluded from the meeting.

Please note that in order to run the meeting to the satisfaction of the majority, competitors must observe the following -

a) Follow the programme and be ready in time for their competitive runs with their cars etc. in the paddock assembly queue.

b) Do not remove competitive vehicles from the circuit until completion of the competition, unless authorized by the Clerk of the Course or his Deputy.

WALKING THE COURSE

Drivers may walk the course up to 08.50 hrs

DRIVER'S BRIEFING

Any novice or driver who has not run the figure of eight course before should attend a driver's briefing at 09.00hrs outside race control.

PRACTICE AND TIMED RUNS

The meeting will have **ONE** practice run. There will be a minimum of **TWO** timed runs per class entered. Should time permit extra runs may be offered to all competitors. The fastest of the timed runs will be used to determine awards. Drivers entering a second class will not be entitled to a second set of practice runs.

DRIVERS ATTIRE:

Applicable Motorsport UK approved Helmets, Overalls and Gloves must be worn by drivers while on track (see below). All items must be inspected & approved at scrutineering (S9.2.1 and K9-K14).

PENALTIES

All four wheels over white line. No time recorded. Dislodging marker posts at both the figure of eight crossover in both directions and on the apex of the first left-hand bend 0.5 seconds.

COMPETITION NUMBERS

All competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to display their correct number at all times and that failure to do so on shared cars will bring about a discounting of both drivers' times until the error is corrected.

RED FLAG

IF THE RED FLAG IS DISPLAYED COMPETING CARS SHOULD COME TO A STANDSTILL WHEN PRACTICABLE AND AWAIT FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE MARSHALS. Q.12.24.3(j)

A catering facility will be open throughout the day for breakfast baps & light lunches etc

ANIMALS

It is a condition of admission to the circuit that no animals are allowed in the paddock area. Any person found in breach of this condition will be deemed a trespasser and will be asked to leave re E2.1.2. Dogs are allowed on leads in the general spectator area.

RESULTS

Practice and provisional competition times will be displayed outside the paddock office. These times may also be displayed at the start. Final results will be published on our website <u>www.amoc.org</u> and at <u>www.tsl-timing.com</u>

PRIZE PRESENTATION

There will be an official presentation of Awards & Trophies at the end of the meeting outside Race Control.

TYRE WARMING

Please note, in accordance with Curborough's instructions there is to be NO tyre warming anywhere at the Venue
